CHARLES RAY CAMPBELL, 74, of Springfield, died Wednesday morning, March 24, 2004 in Community Hospital James Cancer Center.

He was born in Coxton, Kentucky on February 16, 1930 the son of the late William Ray and Jeanella (Ogle) Campbell. He retired as manager of security from EMRO Marketing in 1996 after 35 years of service.
