

**Woman, 73 Is Heart Victim  
Mrs. Short Here With Daughter**

Mrs. Sallie Short, 73, who had been staying the past few weeks with a daughter, Mrs. Marie Slone, at Slone's Nursing Home here, died there at 9:40 a.m. Saturday. Her death was attributed to a heart attack.

Most of her life was spent at Hindman, Ky., but she had resided at Dayton, Ohio, for eight years before coming here.

Born at Hindman, Ky., Jan. 22, 1897, she was the daughter of Wesley and Polly Ann Campbell Sparkman.

She was married to Clabe Short, who died in 1950.

She is survived by 11 children, Claude Short, Commodore Short and Mrs. Bingus (Dorcas) Pigman, all of Columbus, Ohio, Marion Short and Mrs. Leroy (Polly Ann) Pigman, both of Dayton, Ohio, Berlin Short and Mrs. Carlos (Martha) Amburgey, both of Hindman, Ky., Wesley Short, R.R. 6, Greensburg; Linzy Short, Sunman, Mrs. Earl (Mazeda) Miller, Detroit, Mich., and Mrs. John (Marie) Slone, R.R. 4, Greensburg.
