

## **Stanton Wilmont Campbell**

Stanton Wilmont Campbell, 91, of Charleston, WV, passed on to be with his Lord and Savior at 3:25 a.m., Tuesday, January 20, 2004, at The Wellington Nursing & Rehabilitation Center in Urbana, Ohio, where he was a resident for 3 years.

He was born July 28, 1912, in Marysville, Ohio, the son of Walter and Olivia Campbell.

He was retired as a Traffic Controller/Supervisor at the FMC Corporation in Nitro, West Virginia; was a member of the Bible Center Church in Charleston; was a gifted pianist and violinist.
