On this 27th day of January 1853 personally appeared before the undersigned a Justice of the peace for said County, Elizabeth Amburgey (sometimes called Burgey) a resident of Letcher County

State of Kentucky, aged 84 years who being first duly sworn according to law, doth on her oath make

the following declaration in order to obtain the benefit of the provision made by the act of Congress passed July 4th, 1836.

That she is the widow of John Amburgey (or Burgey) who was a volunteer in the Revolutionary war. That he entered the service in the year 1779 and that he served until the year 1781. That he entered the service of the United States under Colonel Benjamin Cleveland and Captain Larkin Cleveland. That he was in the battle of King's Mountain when Ferguson was taken, that he was a resident of Wilkes County State of North Carolina when he entered service and that he received his

She further states that she was married to the said John Amburgey alias Burgey on the third day of July 1787 by aut. [sic] William Hammond and that her name before her said marriage was Elizabeth Harman that her said husband died at Perry County Kentucky on the third day of May 1831 and that she is still a widow. She makes this Declaration for the purpose of obtaining the bounty land to which she may be entitled to under the act approved the 3 March 1855.

That we understood from him that he was after the Indians and Tories to Highwassee [sic, Hiwassee] River, a branch of the Tennessee River.

That their father died on the 3rd day of May 1831 and their mother Elizabeth Amburgey has remained single ever since that period that she has almost lost her reason being so infirm, and it would be impossible to remove her any distance, unless she was taken in a carriage or some other vehicle of that kind. That it is 17 miles to the County seat of this County. That he has claimed to have been a soldier of the Revolutionary war ever since they can recollect, and is so reputed in this County. Given under our hands this 28th of January 1853.

Starting in 1724, and extending through 1726, Spotswood sued many of the Germans, claiming they owed him money, though the basis of the suits has never really been clear. Some believe the suits were to prevent the Germans from moving away from his land to land of their own. It does seem that the foundation on which his claims were based was weak. For example, he sued Conrad Amburger for 32 pounds sterling and a jury of Spotswood's peers awarded Spotswood under 3 pounds sterling. More than anything, the suits say something about the character of Spotswood.

Right now, though, we are more interested in whom he sued, and not the reason why. These are the men:

There is quite a bit of overlap between the Gemmingen list and the importation list. Both of these are thought to consist of 1717ers. The assumption is usually made that all of the men who were sued by Spotswood came in 1717. This adds more names to the list.

Many of the men, who are on one or more of the three lists above, received their patents to land in 1726. Therefore, the names of men receiving land in 1726 adds another dimension; however, only one new set of names is added, John Thomas and his brother Michael Thomas, both of whom were under age, but did receive land in 1726. It is not known whether their father, another John Thomas, came or not. His wife did, because she eventually became the wife of Michael Kaifer, by whom she had five children. The argument that the Thomases came with the 1717ers rests on the fact that Anna Maria Thomas was the sister of the three Blankenbaker men, and the daughter of Anna Barbara Fleshman, who all came. If Anna Maria and her family stayed a while longer in Germany, they were the only members to do so.

Among the land records, Conrad Amberger (Amburgey) received his land patent in 1728, but it was located in another area where the surveyor may have been delayed. He was sued by Spotswood. Andrew Kerker did not get his patent until 1728, but it may have been delayed by the

fact that it was for more than 400 acres. In these cases, approval of the Council of Virginia was required. Continuing the lawsuits by Spotswood against some of the members of the Second Colony, the suits against Jacob Crigler, Andrew Ballenger, Michael Holt, George Utz, Michael Clore and Cyriacus Fleshmen were dismissed. In some cases, the defendant agreed to pay costs. But as we saw with Jacob Crigler, the original amount was over thirty-four pounds sterling, a very sizeable amount. Just for fun, not as an authority, this might be equivalent to thirty-four thousand dollars today. Yet this suit was settled for costs. In the face of actions such as this by Spotswood, one finds it difficult to credit him as a noble character.
